We had a great time traveling to Redding, California with some friends of ours, Tom and Kathie Wise. It was quite a road trip. We drove about 19 hours straight to Clovis, New Mexico. We stayed overnight there with some friends who had lived in Niceville, Florida and were part of our church for a few years, Tom and Susan DiFrancesca. Then we drove 24 hours through New Mexico, Arizona and the deserts of southern California and then up to Redding, CA. We drove through what we thought would be the hottest areas at night. Still, in Needles, CA it was over 100 F at midnight. Redding was also very hot, reaching 105 F while we were there. Good thing it was dry heat and we were in the conference all day each day.

We were very blessed at Bethel Church. The meetings were from 9am to after 9pm each day. The testimonies of healings and miracles were incredible. Kevin Dedmon taught us about going to the streets to do Treasure Hunts. The Treasure is the people God sends you to by word of knowledge who then get healed and in many cases saved, as a result.

Cap Pierce was there and shared about the John G. Lake Healing Rooms the Lord had he and his wife reopen up in Spokane, Washington. Now they oversee 1100 Healing Rooms around the world. They are coming to Helsinki to do some meetings in October this year. Because the Lord highlighted the ministry of healing rooms to me in May this year, Debby and I were very attentive to what we heard there and also at IHOP. We also got to receive ministry in the Healing Rooms at Bethel Church. The Pierces had been members of Bethel Church under Bill Johnson before they moved to Spokane to start their ministry.

A time of joyful dancing and celebration followed until they had to close the meeting for the cleaning crews.

We could see both ends of both rainbows and one appeared to be inside or underneath the other. As we got closer they appeared to be like the leading edge and clearing edge of a huge ring of which we saw one portion. In between the two edges was a solid grey color uniform in presentation from end to end and from edge to edge. That shade of grey was not observable apart from the expanse between these two rainbows. Then as we got closer we saw that we were driving underneath these two bows and it definitely appeared as one solid structure. It was amazing to see.

I asked God what this meant. The thought that crossed my mind was, "The end of destruction." I do not yet know what destruction this signifies an end to, but I believe He will make it clear to me in the days ahead.
